2 Before departure



A negative pre-departure rapid antigen test within 24 hours



Be fully vaccinated (does not apply to Hong Kong residents)

3 After arrival



A "Test and go" arrangement (comprising a PCR test) at the airport

"Amber code" will be given after undergoing PCR test at the airport. Visitors are not required to wait for the result and can return home or any hotel of his/her own choice. No designated transport is required.



3 nights of medical surveillance

Home medical surveillance starts when a negative PCR result is obtained. During the period, they can go out, but they cannot enter premises subject to active checking of the Vaccine Pass, such as restaurants and bars.

4 LeaveHomeSafe App



After arrival, visitors can download the LeaveHomeSafe mobile application and register their profile

Upload the Provisional Vaccine Pass or COVID-19 vaccination record to the app to bring with you during the trip.



In the morning of Day 3, the 'LeaveHomeSafe' application will automatically revert the Amber Code to a Blue Code, if you are tested negative in the PCR test conducted a day before

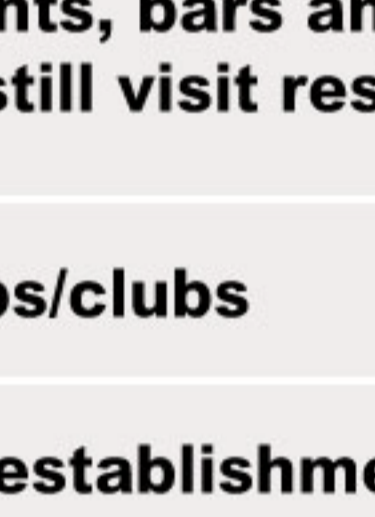


With the Amber Code under Vaccine Pass:

You CAN enter

- Public transports
- Supermarkets/markets*
- Shopping malls*
- Places of public entertainment* (e.g. theme parks, museums, performance venues and racecourses)
- Event premises* (e.g. exhibition venues)
- Barber shops/hair salons
- Religious premises* (e.g. temples and churches)
- Hiking trails
- Outlying islands*

*Excluding catering premises (for dine-in) at these venues



With the Amber Code under Vaccine Pass:

You CANNOT enter

- Restaurants, bars and pubs (for dine-in; you can still visit restaurants for takeaway)
- Nightclubs/clubs
- Karaoke establishments
- Swimming pools
- Fitness centres

For the venues that are not listed on the above table, please further check with the venue owner for the most updated information and the government's website for details of Vaccine Pass.

5 Timeline for "0+3" arrangements

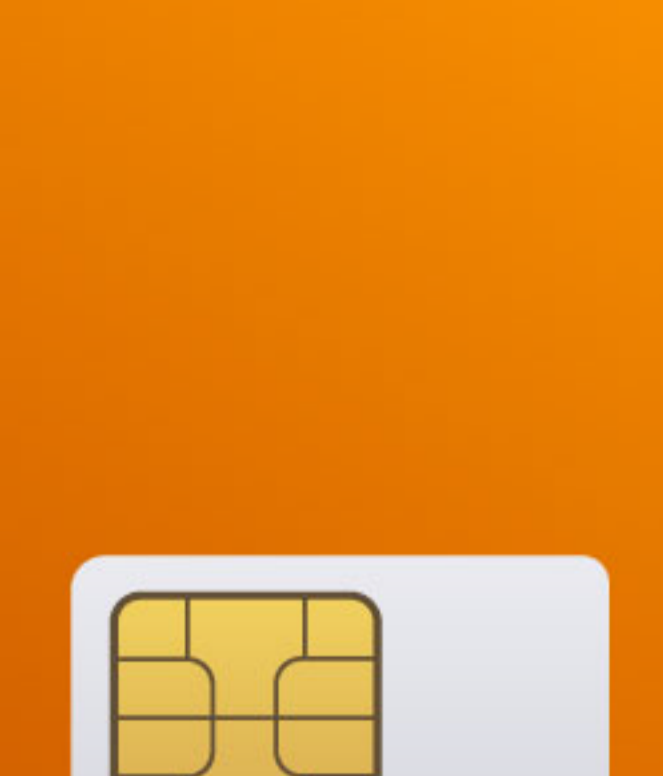
The day of arriving Hong Kong will be counted as day 0

6 Testing arrangements



Visitors can take a PCR-based nucleic acid test at a Community Testing Centre (CTC) or mobile specimen collection stations (for free), or at any recognised local medical testing institutions (self-paid)



Tips: get a local SIM card during your stay in Hong Kong to receive notifications of PCR-based nucleic acid test results via SMS
